In support of this study of the 50h stamp from the Hradčany Fifth Design, I used Volume I of the *Monographs on Czechoslovakian Stamps* and photographs of every position on the panes from Plates I and II. In all, I examined 3,102 stamps which were from every position on both plates. At least one identifying mark was connected to fifty positions. It would be impossible to describe every configuration in words. The written descriptions give an indication but the precise orientation is in the descriptive drawings.

In comparison with the *Monographs*, I found indication of reworked tails on the right dove on 88 stamps. The first through tenth stamps on the pane printed from Plate II may be identified by a double upper frame.
